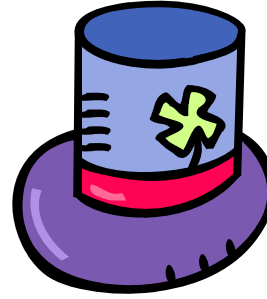

The Four-Leaf Clover Fill-In

When each of the guests arrives, hand them a piece of paper or an index card with a 4-leaf clover drawn in. The leaves of the clover will be blank. Hopefully, by the end of the night, they will have words in all 4 leaves and win a prize.

4 Leaf Clover

It is always lucky to find a four-leaf clover. You know the old saying...if you cannot find one - draw one! Everyone gets a piece of paper and a pencil. They are to put the paper on their head and on the signal...draw a four-leaf clover. The best one wins. Or...you could give everyone a prize for trying.Another twist would be to draw a hat on the four-leaf clover, some eyes, a nose, a mouth and possibly a pipe. Let the people take down their hands first so they can't get it in the right place.

Pot O' Gold Game

St. Patrick's Day Recipes



Pistachio Cake

What you'll need

- 1 pkg yellow cake mix
- 4 eggs, beaten
- 1 pkg. Pistachio instant pudding
- ½ cup oil
- 1-cup sour cream

Topping

- 1-cup ground nuts
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- ¼ cup sugar

Mix the yellow cake mix and pistachio instant pudding together first, then add remaining ingredients. Beat well until smooth. Pour half the batter into greased tube pan. Add ½ of the topping mixture then pour in the rest of the batter. Sprinkle remainder of topping on top. Bake at 350 degrees for 50 minutes. Cool in pan about 20 minutes before removing.

St. Patrick's Day Cake

What you'll need

- 2 baked 8-9 inch white cake layers, cooled
- 2 pkg. (3 oz.) Lime Jell-O
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 (12 oz. Container) Cool Whip

Place cake layers, topsides up, in two clean 8" or 9" layer pans. Prick each cake with a fork at ½" intervals.

Meanwhile, dissolve Jell-o in 2 cups boiling water. Carefully pour ½ of Jell-O over one layer, the remaining over the other. Chill 3 to 4 hours. Dip one cake pan in warm water for 10 seconds, then un-mold onto 10" cake taker and top with about 1 cup cool whip. Unmold second layer carefully onto first layer. Frost top and sides with remaining cool whip. Chill. Garnish with Spearmint leaves or shamrocks (made from green gumdrops.)

7-UP SALAD RECIPE

What you'll need:

- 1 package lime Jell-O
- 1 cup boiling water
- 1 8 oz package cream cheese
- 1 7 oz bottle 7- UP

Mix above in a MIX-N-Stor. When it has started to jell, add a can of Drained crushed pineapple. Add ¾ cups of crushed nuts. Mold in a JEL-RING.
