Hatch An Egg

Fill plastic Easter eggs with jelly beans* and one of the egg cutouts below. Place eggs on Easter grass in a "Tupperware Easter Basket!" Be sure to have enough for all your guests in attendance. The host can play as well.

*For added fun, place a certain color jelly bean in one egg that is only in that one egg. When the guest opens their egg and finds that specific color jelly bean, they receive a free piece of Tupperware from you.

At your party, have each guest take one Easter egg, but tell them not to open it. Tell them that they get to play a game of chance and choice. When they play the game they will get to keep their Easter egg and they get the opportunity to earn even more free Tupperware.

When they open their Easter egg and it says "Free," they get to keep the egg and receive another game gadget. When they open their Easter egg and it says "Me," they get to keep the Easter egg and get YOU to do a party for their friends and family so they can earn even more free Tupperware.

If they don't want to take a chance and play, they simply place the Easter egg back in the Easter basket. If they get "Free" and wanted a "Me" they get another gift from you when they date their party or you can choose to allow them to continue selecting Easter eggs until they open a "Me" Easter egg!
