Features and Benefits

- Airtight Lid: Maintains freshness and keeps humidity, dust, and bugs outside.
- Easy To Open Lid: Everyone in the family will be able to open it! The design of the lid with a prominent tab and the geometry around together with the material selections allows for easy opening. In addition, the tab is wide enough to place a label on it.
- Smart Design for Handling: Easy to grab, the draft on the base leaves some space when they are next to each other, so you can take one without moving the others.
- High Transparency: Identify contents in a blink of an eye.
- Rectangular Shape, Stackability, and Modularity: Space-saving qualities make these containers perfect for any kitchen. These 3 attributes allow for space saving in any kitchen or pantry.
- Incredibly Resistant: Looks like glass but it's virtually unbreakable and more durable. Ultra Clear is made to last, passing our 1.5mts/4.9 ft. drop test.
- One lid fits them all: One lid fits all three different sizes.
- Rim around the lid: Provides ideal stackability and avoids stacked containers to slide off.

How to open

- Place the closed container on a table or other flat, stable surface.
- Hold the container with one hand.
- With the other hand, lift the lid from the tab and pull upward to remove it from container base.

How to close

- Place the filled container on a table or other flat, stable surface.
- Align lid with container base.
- Firmly slide thumbs around edges of rim toward tab.

How to Clean

- Always wash and rinse your product before first use.
- Hand wash only. Tupperware® Ultra Clear Containers are not dishwasher safe. To minimize scratches or avoid damage to the high-gloss finish, hand washing with mild detergent and a soft cloth is pre ferred. Do not use a scouring sponge. Use only non-abrasive, non-chloride cleansers with a Tupperware® Microfiber Towel.

How to Use

- Ideal for storing a range of foods on your countertop, cupboards, or in the pantry.
- For dry storage, here are recommendations:
- 2-cups/ 500 mL is great for loose leaf tea, chocolate chips, mini marshmallows, dried fruits, nuts, spices.
- 4 ½-cup/1 L is great for different types of grains like rice, lentils, beans, bulgur, quinoa, and more. Also short pasta, flour, sugar, crackers, and other snacks.
- 9 ¼-cup/2.2 L is great for cookies, cereals, granola, pasta, tortilla chips, and larger quantities of grains, coffee, and more.
- * Not recommended to use Ginger, citrus, and gummy bears in the Tupperware® Ultra Clear Containers, either as standalone ingredients or in liquid solutions, as they can cause visible damage and discolor products.
- The size of the opening allows for easy filling so there is no need to use a funnel when adding contents inside.
- To minimize scratches and preserve the container's appearance, use only plastic or wood utensils to dispense ingredients.
- Tupperware[®] Ultra Clear Containers are airtight and designed for storing dry foods but can also be used to store semi-liquid or liquid foods in the fridge. Because the containers are not leak-proof always store semi-liquid or liquid ingredients upright to avoid leakage.

Demonstration Ideas & Tips

- o Take a few ingredients in their original packaging and display them on the table. Ask your attendees to take a picture, then pour the ingredients into the Tupperware® Ultra Clear Containers and ask them to take a new picture. Which one will they share on their social media?
- o Open a bag of cookies or chips 7 days before your Tupperware Party. Keep half of the contents in the original package, and store the rest in the Tupperware® Ultra Clear Containers. Allow your participants to check the texture of the contents in each to demonstrate that Tupperware® Ultra Clear Containers keep food fresher.

Color coordinate

o Arrange colorful ingredients inside each size of the Tupperware[®] Ultra Clear Containers to show how a pantry can be color coordinated to make it visually appealing.
